SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Description:

The Brotherhood Educational Scholarship is intended to aid in the further education of members of the Zwingli UCC Church Community. Zwingli members of all ages who are attempting to better themselves through higher education will be considered for this scholarship regardless of their chosen field. This is not a financial based or academic based scholarship. All active members whether in college, university, vocational, technical or developmental programs will be considered. Amounts awarded will be determined annually by an ad-hoc committee appointed annually from Brotherhood members.

Application Process:

To be considered for this scholarship all applicants must complete and submit the following information by May 1 of the year they plan to receive the scholarship.

- **Complete personal information sheet below.** * All responses must be typed to be considered. You may attach additional sheets as needed*
- **Two Letters of Recommendation-**
from a non-family member (ie...Clergy, agents, advisors, neighbors and local business people) These references must speak to your level of commitment as well as personal growth which the reference has noted in the applicants life. They must be submitted with the application in a sealed envelope with the signature of the reference across the seal of the envelope. References must provide contact information for themselves.

Funds must be used within one year of being awarded.
