I have been swimming each morning at the Green County YMCA, rolling out at 5 am, a quick walk with the dog, and then off to the YMCA for a swim. I swim laps, although I am not very good or fast. I tend to let my mind wander and think about scriptures and ideas and concepts as I slowly travel from one end of the pool to the other. I love the feel of the water as it parts above me and wraps around my entire form. Yesterday I thought how this scene would make a great illustration for a devotion! The **Waters of Life**, how we are born of water and how we are reborn in the **Water of Baptism**.

Water is one of the most basic components of life on the planet. Water touches every aspect of our lives from start to finish. Our breathing, our structure, our food, our clothing, our waste cycles all depend on water. Did you know water is a transformative element? It turns rocks into canyons and land into deltas and wetlands. The flow of water seeking the lowest place to rest powers our turbines to create energy, waters our crops, fills our oceans.

And here in the pool at the YMCA, the water is transforming me. I am getting healthier with each stroke. I feel the muscles in my arms and shoulders slowly waking from their slumber. With each stroke I hear the words: "You must be born again!" I think about that phrase as I stroke past the half-way point in my swim time! We are currently changing and adapting, being reborn and transformed from a pile of nutrients and minerals into a flesh bearing being who can hug, help, and care!

Hmmm.... The Waters of Creation, the Waters of Life, the Waters of Transformation and Rebirth! I pray you feel the

transforming power of the Christ at work in your life reanimating and inspiring you to be the image bearer of a loving, caring God! I pray as you pass through this life you will feel the strength rising in your muscles as well as your heart. I pray that all the things that are resistant to your journey slide past you and wrap you in a loving embrace! I pray your life is filled with juicy, watery, emotion filled days. I pray we will all continue to be transformed in the **Living Water!** Amen.




