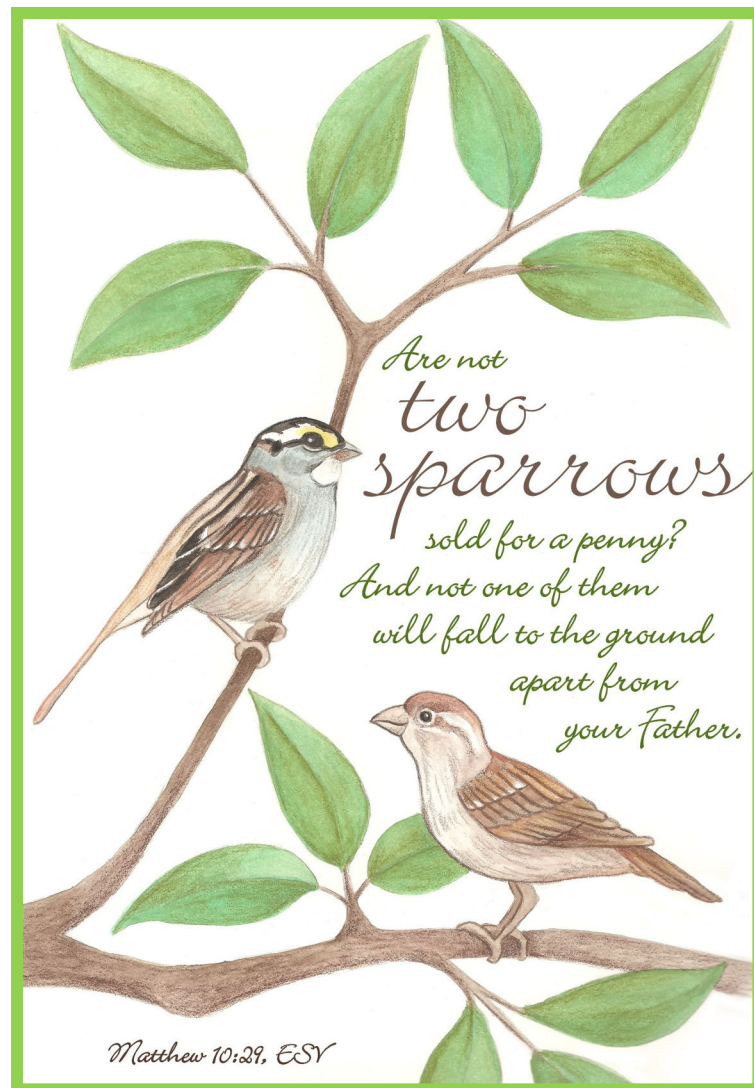

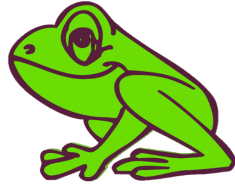

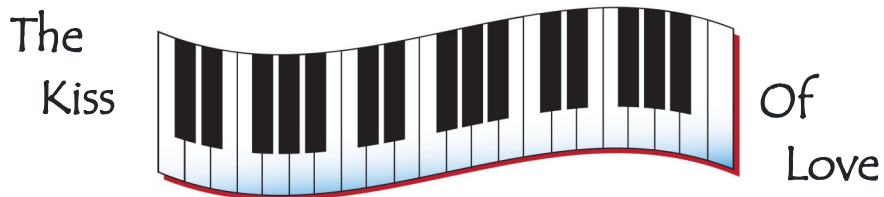

Before the gifted Polish pianist, Ignace Jan Paderewski, died in 1941, he often played concerts in the United States.
