




Altar Guild Updates And Pentecost Geraniums



Red geraniums are back by popular demand for **Pentecost 2025 on June 8th.** As many of you may remember, Zwingli used to decorate our Sanctuary with red geraniums for Pentecost. This year, you will have the opportunity to purchase and/or sponsor flowers. (Watch for the May "Chimes" for details and how to order.)

Because of the plans for the Pentecost flower orders, we will not be selling Easter lilies and spring flowers this year. Our committee felt that with dwindling numbers, the brief time between Easter and Pentecost, and numerous other requests for donations in March and April (i.e., Zwingli Clothing Drive, Blanket Sunday, Kalberwurst Dinner, donations for College and Spring Cheer Bags) that spreading out the opportunity for purchasing flowers would likely be better in May when there were not so many other requests. We will be purchasing a small number of lilies to decorate the Sanctuary for Easter Sunday. The flowers may be available for purchase (cash and carry) following the Easter Service.

The Altar Guild is also very excited to debut our new white Paraments on Easter Sunday. All of our Altar Cloths are relatively old, purchased back in the 1960s, but the white Altar Cloths were in particularly bad shape – discolored, fraying, stained. Using undesignated memorials, we were able to purchase new white Paraments.
